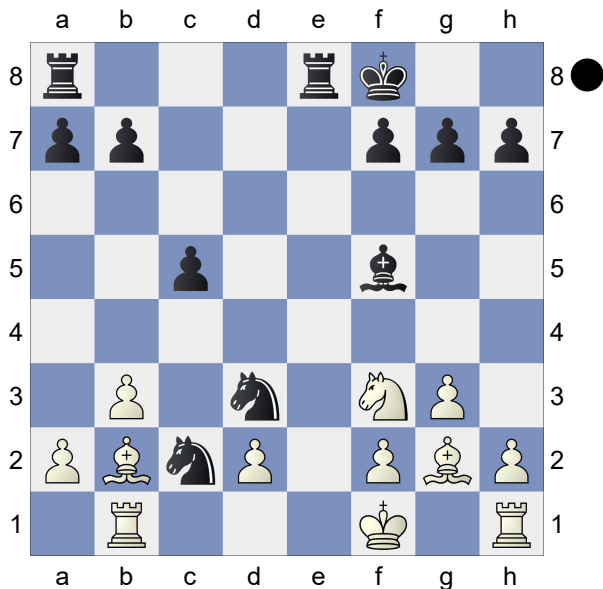
One of the classic blunders of playing Daniel Sevall is to get into a tactical battle with him. So while I thought that 7... Nb4 looked good, I was out of book and extremely wary about what he might have had in store for me. So I spent a lot of time analyzing this move. Was it some sort of crazy gambit? The fact of the matter is that there just aren't a lot of White pieces that can defend the d3 square, but I also had to wonder if there were some tactic or massive advantage in development he could use to overwhelm my position. After all, I was planning to make 4 moves with my knight without touching any other minor pieces. Was that going to be worth it? I couldn't find a refutation, so I made the move. The computer likes it. 8.Nf3 Nd3+ 9.Kf1 Nc6 10.Qe2+ Be7 11.Ne1 Bf5 12.Nd5

I think I've played well and the Stockfish eval is -4.1. But it's honestly not that easy to figure out how to proceed. The computer figures out that neither White's queenside rook nor dark squared bishop have any space to maneuver, and it eventually finds ways to capture them and/or cause problems along the queenside of the board. Slow improvements until something breaks. Over the board, I didn't love that the light-squared bishop was seeing daylight, so I decided to trade off my knight for it. **18...Nxb2 19.Rxb2 Bd3+ 20.Kg1 Nd4?!** Ok this was a real mistake: I missed that the king would be safe after 21. h3. Stockfish 18 considers it a won game after the following moves:
